OID DRY YEAR LEASING PROGRAM

THIS PROGRAM HELPS PATRONS MANAGE WATER DURING THE IRRIGATION SEASON

Patrons can receive a payment for not using their water on-farm. Farmers and fish pay for access to more water. This program supports farms and rivers and is being offered in collaboration with the Deschutes River Conservancy (DRC).



NOT USING YOUR WATER?

Lease irrigation water you aren't using to the temporary water bank and receive a payment.

Your water automatically reverts to its original use the following year.

TEMPORARY WATER BANK

Water leased to the bank can be used by other farmers and to improve flows for fish with a payment to the farmer not using their water.



NEED MORE WATER?

Pay to lease water from the temporary water bank to increase your irrigation allotment and assure you have enough supply for your current crop.



RIVERS NEED WATER

Resident fish and returning steelhead and salmon need water too and DRC can pay to lease water from the temporary water bank.

Participation is 100% voluntary, will not adversely affect patrons who don't participate and is subject to OID approval.
